What is CMS ?

A CMS, or a Content Management System, is a means to manage your website without being an expert in **web design**. This means that maintaining a website does not have to cost a fortune if, it is invested in wisely from the start.

Typically, there are two strands to a CMS. There is the part which allows you to create, delete and modify content without any expert knowledge – this is the CMA (Content Management Application). The second strand is the part that enables delivering those modifications to the live website –the CDA (Content Delivery Application). Put together, a CMS forms a valuable tool for any business.

However, there is more to CMS’s than this. It is a system that can also be used to for marketing purposes. How? Well, perhaps if we name some of the most popular CMS’s, it might make sense. Wordpress is a great example. Here you can write blogs, create websites, use specific themes, customize themes etc. However, in addition to allowing the ‘layman’ to create sophisticated websites, it also allows them to use it for tailoring content and **web design** for specific users. It is a great way to integrate with say, SEO strategies of creating a community by providing customers with interactivity.

So, how does one go about finding the right CMS solution?

One word - simplicity.

In order to gain maximum benefit from your CMS, you should choose one which has a simple interface – this is, one that is easy to operate and navigate through. From a user perspective, it can mean creating a site that is suitable for all types of people rather than just those who are IT savvy.

A busy restaurant is always a sign of good quality food but, does it guarantee that their menu will be to your taste? A CMS that has a big following does not necessarily mean that it is good or more importantly, suitable for your business needs. Have a look at the extensions, plug-ins, interface, templates etc and make an independent judgement rather than following the crowd. Notably, a CMS with a small following is not necessarily the way to go either. The secret recipe is finding one that provides the functions that you need.

As with most things, doing your homework can be very informative in helping you choose the right CMS. Interact with the online community to see what others think.
